The price of meals continues to rise, which has led to an increase of the members' contribution of £6 towards their meal, and with the continuing increase in the cost of meals, it clear to see that the walking section will not have sufficient funds to cover the year to be able to maintain the subsidy at the current discount, and a significant rise in the members' contribution will needed around June/ July time.

The BTASSC Walking Section has a membership of 32, consisting of 17 BTASSC members/families and 15 affiliated members. The average turnout was 17, ranging from 11 to 22 people.
